1. How does your group make decisions about group issues, such as meeting format or how much money to contribute to other levels of service?

2. How does your group decide on local service issues, such as area motions that have been sent back to the groups, or does your group even do that?

3. Does your group have requirements about who is allowed to vote on group issues? On ASC issues? For those groups that do, have you discussed the reason for these requirements as a group, or is it simply accepted as “the way our group has always done it?”

4a. What level of involvement does your home group want on area or regional (or world) matters?

4b. What specific kinds of area or regional (or world) decisions do you think your home group should consider?

4c. What kinds of decisions do you think your home group should delegate?

5. How can groups hold service bodies accountable for decisions the groups weren't directly involved in making?

6. How can service bodies exercise the authority delegated to them by the groups and remain "directly responsible to those they serve?"
